**sum, es, est / sunt; (impf.) erat / erant**

\*Note that the verb 'to be' is irregular in English also, so you must change it to fit the required sense. We don't say 'I be', but 'I am'; not 'you be', but 'you are', etc. The imperfect of 'to be' should be 'he/she was', not 'he/she was being'; and simply 'they were', not 'they were being'.
