Adjective endings In adjectives, terminations in ‘-a’ etc. denote that the modified noun is ‘feminine’; terminations in ‘-us’ etc. denote that the modified nouns is ‘masculine’ in gender; the adjective termination in ‘-um’ denote neuter gender.
