Comparative

melior, melius – better
beviōr, brevius – briefer
cārīor, cārīus – dearer
difficilior, difficilīus
 – more difficult
māior, māius – bigger
pēior, pēius – worse
minor, minus – smaller
stultior, stultius – more foolish

Superlative

optimus, -a, -um – best
brevissimus, -a, -um – briefest
cārrimus, -a, -um – dearest
difficillimus, -a, -um
 – very difficult
maximus, -a, -um – biggest
pessimus, -a, -um – worst
minimus, -a, -um – smallest
